HTML Text Elements

Wiki Markup Text Elements

`<p>`This defines a paragraph`</p>`

(empty line) Produces a new paragraph

`
` (creates a line break)

`\\` (creates a line break)

`<hr />` (creates a horizontal rule)

`----` (creates a horizontal rule)

HTML Comments and Special Characters

Wiki Markup Comments and Special Characters

`<!--` This is a comment `-->`

{HTMLcomment} This is a comment
{HTMLcomment}

`<` an ampersand (&), an entity name or a # and an entity number, and a semicolon (;)
i.e `<` is the same as `<`

`\x` (backslash and then character, i.e. `\{`)

Bulleted (unordered):

```
<ul>
<li>First item</li>
<li>Next item</li>
</ul>
```

Numbered (ordered):

```
<ol>
<li>First item</li>
<li>Next item</li>
</ol>
```

<table>
<tr>
<td>row 1, cell 1</td>

Wiki Markup Lists

Bulleted (unordered):

```
* First Item
* Second item
```

Make sure that a space follows the *. Use additional asterisks (i.e. **) for subgroupings.

Numbered (ordered):

```
# First Item
# Second item
```

Make sure that a space follows the #. Do not leave any blank lines, or another numbered list will be created.

Wiki Markup Images

```
!image.png!
```

with attributes:

```
!image.png|width=100, height=50, alt=Logo,
title=Logo!
```

an image from a remote site:

```
!http://www.tufts.edu/home/images/tufts_wo
rdmark.png|width=100, height=50, alt=Logo,
title=Logo!
```

Wiki Markup Tables

|row1 cell 1| row1 cell 2|
|row2 cell 1| row2 cell 2|
